SUBJECT: Suggested Format for Requesting a Certificate of Divestiture

The U.S. Office of Government Ethics (OGE) has developed a suggested format for agencies to use when requesting Certificates of Divestiture for their employees. Because the format contains a checklist of information you should provide to OGE with the request, using it may help you avoid delays in the processing of your requests.
